## Main University Building (Main Arts)

The entrance to Main Arts is via a ramp or steps through sliding doors that lead into the main Foyer area.



#### LOCATION

Main University Building (Main Arts) (51), College Road, Bangor, LL57 2DG

## TRAIN

Bangor is the nearest station (10 – 15 min walk away). Information on train times can be found on the National Rail Enquiries site: www.nationalrail.co.uk/

## DRIVING

The University is signposted from the A5/A55 Expressway. Post Code: LL57 2DG.

#### **CAR PARKING (P)**

The nearest car parks are Main Arts and Bryn Afon located either side of College Road. The barrier should be raised on the day **BUT PLEASE** remember the Barrier Code and to display the parking permit (above).
