<u>VENUE</u>

Approach by A55, coast Road ...

Exit A55 at Bangor / Betws-Y-Coed, J11 Follow A5 towards Betws-Y-Coed for 2 miles LEFT at crossroads, signed Rachub

Approach by A5 ...

1/2 mile after leaving the village of Bethesda RIGHT at crossroads, signed Rachub

... from the crossroads, signed Rachub

From the crossroads proceed up the hill

After 1 mile turn LEFT in village centre leaving Royal Oak pub on right & Post Office on left.

After approx. 200 metres reach Llanllechid village (playing field on your right), carry straight on.

When you reach the RED phone box on right, turn RIGHT and immediately RIGHT again (single track road).

After approx. 250m when road markings bear sharp right, DO NOT turn right instead continue left straight onwards along the track.

After 100 metres you will enter the Outreach site, please report to staff on arrival.

Please note

Satellite navigation systems will not usually follow these directions, however, this is the most straight forward and clear route.
